

## Auglaize County ESC VPN Remote Access Setup

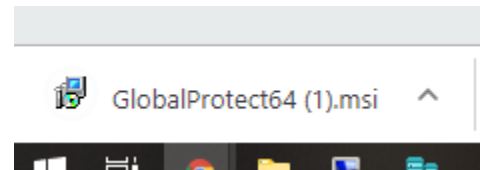
In order to access files stored on the file server at the ESC, you will need to have a VPN client set up on your device. To begin, open any web browser and go to <https://vpn.woco-k12.org> and download the applicable GlobalProtect agent as shown to the right. You will need to log in using your WOCO DASL/Progressbook account.

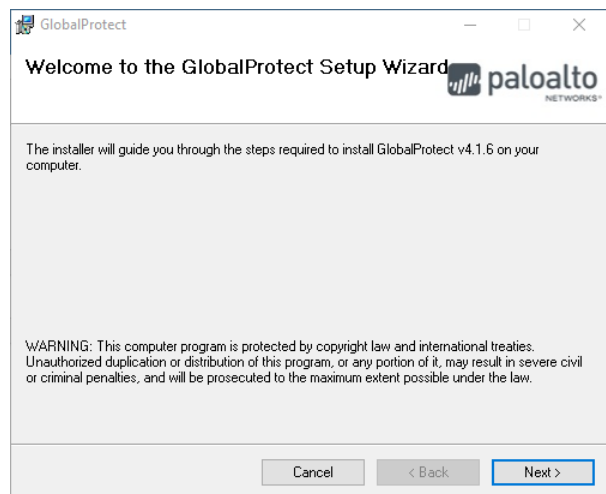

Once your download is complete, click on the downloaded file. You may be prompted to allow administrative rights, click yes.



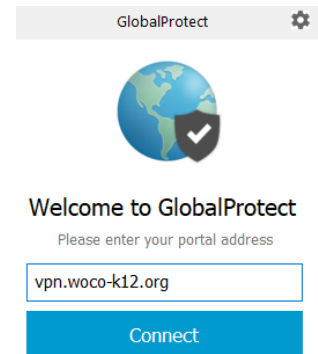

Once you allow the program to run, the setup wizard will open. Simply click next through the prompts and installation will begin. Click on close once the installer gets to the "GlobalProtect has been successfully installed" page.

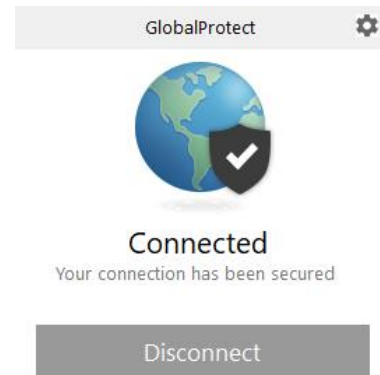


## Auglaize County ESC VPN Remote Access Setup

In the window that appears after the installation finishes, type in `vpn.woco-k12.org` as the portal address and click connect. Use your WOCO ProgressBook username and password.



Once connected, you the box will either go away into the taskbar or you will see a window similar to this.



When you are finished accessing your files, you will need to disconnect. To disconnect, click the up arrow in your taskbar by the time then click the globe icon and click on disconnect.
